
CHRIST IS RISEN

FIRST READING

Acts 10.34a, 36-43++

We ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles.

- 34 Peter began to speak to those assembled in the house of Cornelius.
- 36 "You know the message God sent to the people of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ— he is Lord of all.
- 37 That message spread throughout Judea,

beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John announced:

- 38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.
- 39 "We are witnesses to all that he did both in Judea and in Jerusalem.

They put him to death by hanging him on a tree;

- 40 but God raised him on the third day and allowed him to appear,
- 41 not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses, and who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.
- 42 "He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one ordained by God as judge of the living and the dead.
- 43 All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name."
